Course outline

The CIOB Level 4 Diploma in Construction Site Management is designed for construction site managers working in the construction sector who are progressing into managing larger and more complex projects. The qualification develops the students' knowledge and skills to plan and programme projects, liaise with stakeholders and oversee large or complex construction projects safely and efficiently.

Candidates for the Diploma in Site Management need to undertake nine units.

Entry requirements

Any qualification with a minimum of 32 UCAS Points, including:

- Level 3 S/NVQ, or equivalent, in a construction-related subject
- CIOB Level 3 Award in Supervising Construction Works to Existing Buildings and Structures
- CIOB Level 3 Award in Supervising the Construction of New Buildings and Structures
- CIOB Level 3 Diploma in Site Supervisory Studies

or

• Three years' relevant construction experience

Being computer literate is advantageous for this course if no formal qualifications are held.

Course duration

The course is run over two years and is delivered on one half-day per week.
